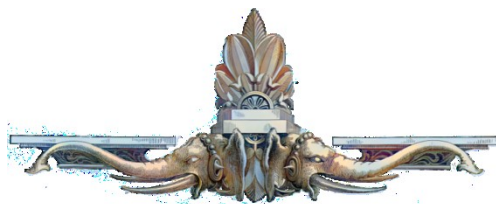

## **Initial Warnings**

For a language to be universally accepted, it needs to meet the following conditions: Be useful; Be logical; Be easy to understand, learn, memorize, and use; Be fun and playful; Be culturally neutral; Anticipate mechanisms for its continuous development. The Símbio language aims to meet all these conditions.

It is worth noting that if the usual process of learning and using any foreign language includes three fundamental stages: 1. Understanding the meaning of a word; 2. Memorization; and 3. Use. The process of learning and using the Símbio language is different and consists of five stages: 1. Understanding and memorizing universes and symbols. 2. Reading and combinatorial and logical analysis of each word. 3. Deduction of meaning and understanding. 4. Active memorization through deduction. 5. Reuse through reading and understanding or through writing, reuse, or creation.

The symbols of the Símbio language were chosen because they are easy to identify, memorize, and differentiate from each other. Invest some time in getting familiar with them. The Símbio language is logical, and therefore, it accepts linguistic nuances and variations. Be open to learning not only the words from the official dictionary but also the meanings that users can create themselves. That is the main characteristic of the Símbio language. You have the ability to read and understand a word when seeing it for the first time, using the deduction process.

## About the Author and the Invention

Curiosity leads me to be persistent in studies and to discover problems. Creativity makes me unite spirituality (☩) with knowledge (Δ) to be able to create, develop, and propose new useful solutions.

The Símbio language (⊕sb) is a language of symbols that can be used immediately by the deaf community (⊗) as a new sign language (⊕) or by internet users worldwide as an alternative language for global communication on the internet (@). It can now also be spoken (version 2.0.0).

It was developed for those with limited capacity or great difficulty in written communication. The Símbio language is the result of a creative look (☺) and a simplifying mind (Π). It was created and developed to globally break down all barriers (⊖) to written communication between people of any condition and ability.

The Símbio language is a logical and combinatorial language of symbols. It was developed and patented at the Brazilian National Institute of Industrial Property (INPI) along with a specific keyboard that allows writing in Símbio on a computer.

The Símbio language can be used immediately on the "Whatsapp web" messaging service after installing the virtual keyboard I developed for the Windows 10 operating system, which you can download for free from my website.

I need to emphasize that the Símbio language was developed to be written by hand on paper if necessary. Therefore, all symbols that make up the language were selected with care.

There are many barriers to written communication in the world, such as very complex symbol alphabets, illiteracy, hearing or cognitive impairments, social inequalities, among others.

I developed the logical structure of the Símbio language and the dictionary for all those who do not have the ability to communicate in writing due to any of these barriers. The Símbio language will be of great utility for all deaf people, illiterates, polyglots, and internet users worldwide.

The Símbio language is being published for the first time in Brazil (☐br), in the Portuguese language (⊕pt), and as a Brazilian invention (φ~). This is because, although I am French (♂fr) and Spanish (♂es), I have lived in Brazil for over twenty years. But soon I will publish a French version (⊕fr) and subsequently an English version (⊕en) of this work.

## **Author's Note**

The Símbio language is a linguistic and written communication system that can be succinctly defined as a language of symbols, logical, intuitive, flexible, dynamic, easy to learn, and enjoyable.

The creation of the Símbio language as the language of the Ceti Order is part of a broader mission that encompasses various humanistic and spiritual projects.

In practice, the Símbio language will help many people to communicate. First, the global deaf community that still lacks a written sign language. Second, the community of illiterates who struggle to master any complex written language. Third, the community of individuals who feel incapable of learning a complex foreign language. Fourth, the global community of polyglots who wish to learn a new language that is simple and intuitive, allowing communication in writing with a large number of people. The Símbio language can assist billions of people because it was created to be simple and useful!

The logical structure of the Símbio language was born at the end of the year 2022. I developed the first version of the Símbio dictionary throughout the year 2023. At the end of 2023, I decided to publish the first version of the Símbio language, as an incomplete work with an initial dictionary comprising over a thousand words, making it available for use at the beginning of 2024.

The Símbio language, in its current version, is not being published as a fixed and inflexible structure but as a communication system—organized, creative, and intuitive.

The name of the language, "Símbio," was chosen in collaboration with my daughter, to whom I give credit for it. The name Símbio was subsequently redefined with the help of artificial intelligence as "Integrated Message System Based on Organized Icons." A definition that well represents the proposal and functioning of the Símbio language.

The Símbio language was created by me for the members of the Ceti Order. The reasons that motivated me to complete the project are:

Creation of a new logical, easy, and intuitive language.

The Símbio language can be used globally by internet users without needing to use another language.

The Símbio language can serve as a foundation for the creation and development of new internet applications.

Personal and non-commercial use of the Símbio language is free. This means that you can learn the Símbio language here and start using it with whomever you want. To do this, you will need to create a new layout for your keyboard on Windows with the symbols of the Símbio language. It is an advanced and manual procedure.

The conditions for commercial use of the Símbio language are detailed below.

The Símbio language presented in this work was created by the Author, César Ramos.

## **Ceti Order**

1. The Ceti Order is a spiritual and human organization composed of righteous women and men. Its main objective is to promote peace, harmony, and the preservation of the human race.
2. The order believes in the connection between spirituality and intelligence, having its headquarters in the soul and intelligence of its members.
3. The Order follows a monarchical structure, with the Grand Master, Esrac, as its spiritual leader responsible for guiding and inspiring members on the journey of discovering Ceti ethics.
4. The organization has seven degrees or levels: Reader, Student, Aspirant, Gentleman, Vice Commander, Commander, and Grand Master.
5. Anyone who shares the values and ethical principles of the Ceti Order, regardless of their faith or creed, can identify as a member of the order and contribute to the promotion of its ethics, values, and soul enlightenment.
6. The 4 Mottos of the Ceti Order are:
  - a. "Mors non apprehendet iustum." Death shall not reach the just.
  - b. "Regnum est in vobis." The kingdom is within you.
  - c. "Defendat me ab iniuria." Protect me from injustice.
  - d. "Fortis fortuna adiuvat." Fortune favors the brave.



7. Members of the Ceti Order hold seven supreme values, seven fundamental aspirations, seven moral and social duties, seven cardinal virtues, and one fundamental principle.
  - a. Seven Supreme Values: Life, Liberty, Family, Peace, Homeland, Ethics, and Fraternity.
  - b. Seven Fundamental Aspirations: Well-being, Happiness, Education, Development, Social Utility, Tranquility, and Intimacy.
  - c. Seven Moral and Social Duties: Honesty, Legality, Justice, Responsibility, Commitment, Diligence, and Solidarity.
  - d. Seven Cardinal Virtues: Love, Kindness, Temperance, Prudence, Empathy, Wisdom, and Discipline.
  - e. One Principle: Faith and connection with the Lord.
8. The 9 Ceti Commandments are:
  - a. Be authentic and true.
  - b. Cultivate wisdom.
  - c. Practice justice and intelligence.
  - d. Develop your virtues.
  - e. Love unconditionally.
  - f. Have faith.
  - g. Be prudent.
  - h. Be bold and courageous.
  - i. Do not stray from the Lord.



## **Book I – Símbio Language**

1. The Símbio Language is the interstellar communication language of the Ceti Order.
2. The Símbio Language is a communication tool created by and for the members of the Ceti Order.
3. The use of the Símbio Language, in any space and environment, implies full acknowledgment of the supreme values, principles, and ethical laws of the Ceti Order.
4. Using the Símbio Language means adhering to and agreeing with all the principles and values contained in the sacred books of the Ceti Order.
5. The Lord is the grand architect of the Símbio Language.

### Chapter I

#### **About the Simbio language**

1. Símbio means "Integrated System of Message Based on Organized Icons."
2. The basic unit of the Símbio Language is the symbol, also called an icon or character.
3. The Símbio Language has been adapted to the UNICODE project (Unicode Consortium) to be immediately usable and applicable with computers, mobile phones, and digital technologies on the internet.
4. Any symbol from the UNICODE project can be used to create new words.
5. The Símbio Language interconnects various symbols (or icons) to produce a message or word.
6. A message formed by a single symbol is called a "universe."

7. The universe is the building block that serves as the foundation for the Símbio Language.
8. A symbol that does not represent a message is called a character, letter, symbol, or Unicode.
9. A message formed by a combination of various symbols is called a "word."

## Chapter II

### **On the Development of the Símbio Language**

1. The Símbio language is not static but dynamic.
2. Any new word must be developed respecting two principles: Intuition and Simplicity.
3. Intuition is a fundamental characteristic of the Símbio language. It corresponds to the fact that a word seen for the first time should have a high probability of being guessed by the observer.
4. Simplicity requires that all words in the Símbio language be as short as possible and as intuitive as possible, using only a few symbols.
5. Symbols should be chosen because the drawing they represent already carries a meaning that can be easily explained, taught, imagined, and memorized.
6. For example, we can teach that the symbol  $\odot$  looks like an eye and represents the universe of "vision."
7. We can also teach that the symbol  $\oplus$  is a round mouth with 4 teeth and represents the symbol of language or speech.
8. We can also teach that the symbol  $\$$  is a symbol representing the universe of money.



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9. We can also teach that the symbol  $\chi$  is the Chi Rho cross representing the universe of religion.
10. The Símbio language is based on logic, thus freeing the creativity of the expresser, as messages with similar meanings can theoretically be produced with different combinations of symbols.
11. The Símbio language does not depend on vocal cords or sounds but can be adapted to be spoken, if necessary, through the arbitrary allocation of phonemes (sounds) to universes and symbols.
12. The Símbio language can be taught and learned quickly because it is a logical and intuitive language, making it easy to interpret and learn.
13. It is a lot of fun to learn and guess the words of the Símbio language.
14. Additionally, the Símbio language can be taught and used with illiterates as an initial literacy technique.
15. In theory, the language can be used to communicate with any advanced intelligence since it is based on logic.

## Chapter III

### **Initial Objectives**

1. The Símbio language was created to be a universal written language that facilitates digital communication over the internet, without relying on a traditional language, whatever it may be.
2. The Símbio language was initially created for the deaf community and internet users, future members of the Ceti Order.

## Chapter IV

### **Structure**

1. The basic unit of the language is the universe.
2. A universe is represented by a single symbol representing a message.
3. Symbols representing universes should be chosen for their visual characteristics or because they have become standardized symbols for certain meanings and messages.
4. Synonyms in the Símbio language are different symbols that carry the same message, i.e., the same meaning.
5. A word is a message created by the combination of two or more universes.
6. Symbols are read from left to right and in lines from top to bottom and are interpreted as a whole, i.e., as a combination of symbols.

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7. This means that, theoretically, inverting the rules for reading symbols (from right to left, for example) should not significantly distort the meaning of the word.
8. Words should be created with logical and appropriate combinations of universes, i.e., symbols.
9. Words can be either appropriate or confusing, just as a message can be clear or confusing.
10. An appropriate word produces a clear message when formulated logically and without ambiguity.
11. A confusing word lacks logic and produces a confusing or ambiguous message.
12. The use of the Símbio language is an art.
13. The vocabulary of the Símbio language is not standardized.
14. Users can create words, provided they are unambiguous and have the ability to become understandable messages.
15. Sentences follow the following order: Subject, Verb, and Object.
16. The sentence ends with a period.
17. Words can be separated by commas.
18. The written language is called Símbio ( $\oplus S_b$ ), and the spoken language is called Símbion ( $\oplus S_{bn}$ ).
19. The Símbio language depends on the transcription of the Símbio language into sounds through arbitrarily defined phonemes by linguists, called symbions.



## **Book II – Universes and symbols**

### Chapter I

#### **Universes**

1. Universes are the morphemes of the Símbio language.
2. The list of universes is not static but dynamic.
3. A universe is formed by a single symbol.
4. A universe simultaneously signifies a word and a universe.
5. By universe, one should understand a meaning that can be derived and combined to form other secondary meanings.
6. Universes are primary words that do not depend on any other word and are arbitrarily defined through symbols, by convention, and by the linguist.
7. Universes are the bricks that serve as the foundation for building words and the Símbio language.
8. Universes should neither be excessive nor too few. Practice will determine the appropriate quantity of universes, which, at the moment, is pure speculation.
9. Universes should be evident, simple, intuitive, and combinable. A universe that is not combinable or intuitive is not a useful universe.
10. The table below presents the initial list of universes that I have created.
11. This is a flexible table that will grow as the vocabulary of the Símbio language expands.
12. The first column indicates the meaning in the Portuguese language, the second column indicates the arbitrary allocation of a phoneme (sound) that I named "Symbion,"

the third column indicates the symbol, and the fourth column indicates the Unicode code of the symbol.

13. The current table contains 51 universes, 51 symbols, and 51 symbions.

## Chapter III

### Meaning of Symbols

1. The Símbio language uses the UNICODE project as a potential alphabet of symbols.
2. The Unicode table (version 15.0) contains 149,186 different characters and allows the written transcription of over 160 modern and historical languages.
3. In the Windows operating system and MS Word, Unicode symbols (U+) can be typed by entering the symbol code and then pressing Alt + X, which transforms the code into a Unicode symbol.
4. It is possible to customize a keyboard layout for typing in Símbio.

5. Symbols that are complex to write by hand and too similar to each other, leading to potential confusion, should be avoided.
6. The list of symbols that can be used to develop the vocabulary of the Símbio language, along with the universes, is not fixed, and creativity and logic should be used in their selection.
7. The current list includes 66 symbols, each with meanings presented below.
8. The difference between a universe and a symbol lies in the fact that a symbol has the ability to modify or complement the meaning of a universe to produce a new word.
9. In most cases, a symbol cannot be derived to form new words and is used as a complement.
10. Some symbols share the derivation capability of universes but are still considered symbols because they are used less frequently or participate in the formation of a few common words. Examples include the symbols representing birth (θ) and death (†).

## Chapter IV

### **Símbions of the Universes**

1. The Símbio language is a written language that has been encoded with phonemes for spoken communication.
2. The phonemes of the Símbio language are called Símbions.
3. Símbions are simple sounds (phonetic structures) that are easy to pronounce for anyone from any background or country and can be synthesized through technology and artificial intelligence.
4. Símbions are distinctive sounds that have contrastive value in the Símbio language.
5. They are the basic elements that make up the phonological system of the language and are represented between oblique bars (/ /) in phonetic transcription.
6. The Símbions of the universes are phonemes formed by two letters, one vowel and one consonant, chosen arbitrarily by the linguist. For example, ba, be, bi, bo bu. In other words, Ação (ba), Água (be), Alimento (bi), Emoção (bo), and Animal (bu).
7. Each universe must have a unique phoneme to mitigate the risk of confusion for both the listener and the speaker. In other words, there can be no repetitions of Símbions.
8. The Símbions of the symbols are sounds (i.e., phonemes) formed by three letters, one consonant, one vowel, and one consonant, chosen arbitrarily by the linguist.
9. The number of letters allows differentiation between Símbions of the universes (2 letters) and symbols (3 letters).

10. The linguist must choose easily pronounceable Símbions and avoid unnecessary accentuation of vowels, such as in the French language, where accentuation of the letter "e" produces similar vowels with different sounds like "é" and "è," creating confusion.
11. When creating new Símbions, the linguist should limit the use of unambiguous vowels such as a, e, i, o, u.
12. The phonetic transcription of the Símbions of the universes is presented below.

13. The Símbion "Ka" means "house", and the Símbion "Ke" means "knowledge". Therefore, a speaker should pronounce the word school (⊠ Δ) as "kake," which has the following phonetic transcription /kake/.
14. Similarly, the Símbion "Da" means "money". Therefore, a speaker should pronounce the word "bank" (⊠ \$) as "kada," which has the following phonetic transcription /kada/, and the word "loja" (⊠ &) as the word /kako/.
15. Thus, the verb "love" (Ä♥) should be pronounced /babo/, just as the adjective "loved" (ËÄ♥) should be pronounced

/dobabo/, and the adjective "closed" (Ξ|) should be pronounced /doclo/.

16. In the presence of two vowels, they will be joined. Thus, the adjective "opened" (Ξ\ ) will be pronounced /dope/.

2. When two vowels meet in a certain word, the linguist must choose the most appropriate vowel.
3. When two consonants meet, the linguist should include the vowel "a". For example, "rd" is pronounced /rad/.
4. The transcription of three-letter codes is done using the table above or the Latin transcription, whichever is better.
5. For example, the word "pumpkin" ( $\Psi$ pum) can be pronounced in three ways: "bipimuveama" or "bipimuvama" or "Bipum". In this case, the linguist should choose the Latin version "Bipum".
6. Similarly, the word "Avocado" ( $\Psi$ avc) can be pronounced in three ways: "biamavitaci" or "biavac" (including the vowel "a" between the consonants "v" and "c").
7. Thus, the color violet ( $\nabla$ prp) is pronounced "kuparap" the color pink ( $\nabla$ pnk) "kupanak," the color indigo ( $\nabla$ ind) "kuinda," the color blue ( $\nabla$ blu) "kublu," the color green ( $\nabla$ grn) "kugaran," the color yellow ( $\nabla$ yel) "kuyela," the color orange ( $\nabla$ org) "korag," the color red ( $\nabla$ red) "kureda," the color gray ( $\nabla$ gry) "kugari," the color white ( $\nabla$ wht) "kuwuit," the color black ( $\nabla$ blk) "kubalak," and the color brown ( $\nabla$ brn) "kubaran."

## Book III – Word Formation

### Chapter I

#### Combinations

1. Words are created through a combination of Símbions.
2. The universe is a primitive word representing a primitive meaning arbitrarily defined and allocated by the linguist. For instance, the symbol  $\square$  means "house," and the symbol  $\Delta$  means "knowledge."
3. These symbols are not chosen randomly. The square visually represents a house or building. The triangle pointing upward conveys the idea of elevation, just as knowledge enhances the capabilities of the mind.
4. Hence, the linguist choosing the symbols must be human and not an artificial intelligence. This is to ensure that the symbols are easy to handwrite and that they have a visual resemblance or some connection to the defined meaning.
5. A primary word is one formed by combining two meanings, i.e., two universes or one universe and one symbol.
6. For example, by adding the knowledge symbol  $\Delta$  to the house symbol  $\square$ , we form the primary word "school," as follows:  $\square\Delta$ .
7. A secondary word is one formed by combining three universes.
8. For instance, by adding the language or speech symbol  $\oplus$ , we create a complex word  $\square\Delta\oplus$ , meaning language school.

9. If we add the internet symbol @, we form an even more complex word  $\square\Delta\oplus@$ , signifying a virtual language school.
10. Words are created by combining meanings, and the combination can be described, such as the word "virtual language school" described as the "house of knowledge of languages on the internet," i.e.,  $\square\Delta\oplus@$ .

1. Words are created through a combination of symbols.
2. The word  $\square\Delta$  means school, and the message should be interpreted as the "house of knowledge."
3. The word  $\square\&$  means store, and the message should be interpreted as the "house of commerce."
4. The word  $\square\$$  means bank, and the message should be interpreted as the "house of money."
5. The word  $\square\$@$  means digital bank, and the message should be interpreted as the "house of money on the internet."
6. The word  $\square\Delta@$  means virtual school, and the message should be interpreted as the "house of knowledge on the internet."
7. The word  $\square\text{✕}$  means church, and the message should be interpreted as the "house of religion."
8. The word  $M\$$  means honesty, and the message should be interpreted as the "virtue of money."
9. The word  $\text{♂}\square\Delta$  means student, and the message should be interpreted as "the man who attends the house of knowledge."

## **Book XX – Símbio Virtual Keyboard (Windows 10)**

I have developed two keyboards for the Símbio language:

1. A physical keyboard that I designed to be manufactured in the future.
2. A virtual keyboard (Windows 10) so that the Símbio language can be used immediately on a traditional Qwerty keyboard.  
The personal use of the virtual keyboard I developed is free.

I have not yet developed virtual keyboards for Mac or mobile devices (Android or iPhone).

### Chapter I

#### **Presentation of the Keyboards**

##### Símbio Physical Keyboard

A patent application has been filed in Brazil with the National Institute of Industrial Property (INPI) for the initial layout of the Símbio keyboard.

At the moment, as there is still no physical keyboard to write in the Símbio language, I have developed a virtual keyboard so that users can use the language immediately.

## Symbolic Language Símbio

### Símbio Virtual Keyboard

The Símbio Virtual Keyboard is a specific configuration of the Qwerty keyboard layout that allows you to write in the Símbio language on the computer.

To use the Símbio Virtual Keyboard, you need to install the keyboard on a computer with Windows, with a standard QWERTY keyboard, an internet connection, and the WhatsApp application for the computer ("WhatsApp Web").

All symbols on the Símbio virtual keyboard have been tested through WhatsApp Web.

I developed the Símbio keyboard for Windows using a specific Microsoft program created for this purpose. Therefore, you should not trust any version that has not been downloaded from my site.

I recommend that you do not install any pirated version on your machine, as it may contain viruses.

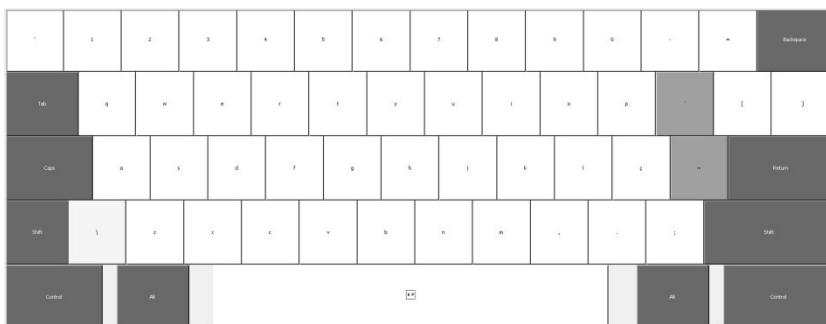
The virtual keyboard is free. Therefore, there is no reasonable reason for you not to download the official version from my website.

## Chapter II

### The Virtual Keyboard

After installation and selection (see installation section), the Símbio Virtual Keyboard can be used as follows:

1. First Layer: In the first layer of the Símbio Virtual Keyboard, you have normal access to all lowercase Latin letters on the QWERTY keyboard with the Brazilian ABNT 2 configuration. But only lowercase letters. It is worth mentioning that when selecting the Símbio keyboard on your computer, you will no longer have access to uppercase letters in the traditional way.

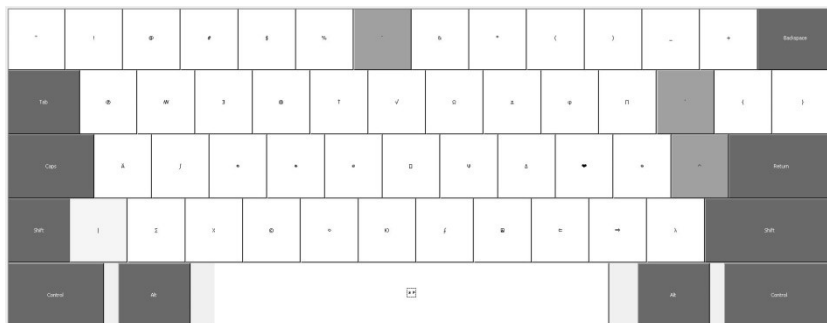

5. Fifth Layer: Access the fifth layer (uppercase) by using the combination of the keys (Shift + Ctrl). To access the fifth layer of the keyboard, simultaneously press the "Shift" key plus the "Ctrl" key (with your left hand). In the fifth layer, you will have access to all Latin uppercase letters and shortcuts for pronouns using the numeric keys 1 (yos), 2 (tus), 3 (ele), 4 (ela), 5 (nos), 6 (vos), 7 (les), 8 (las), 9 (tot), 0 (tod), and - (yon)..

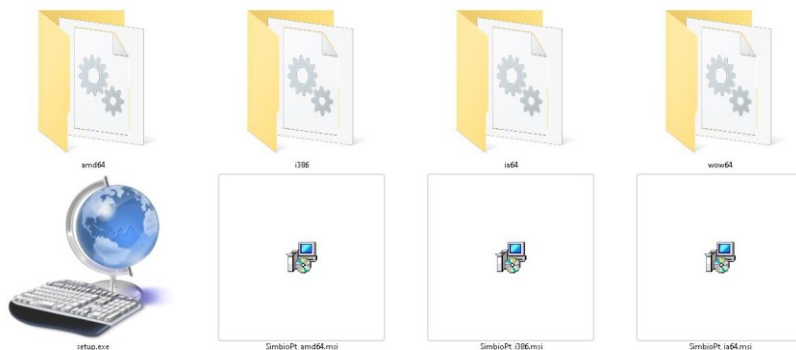

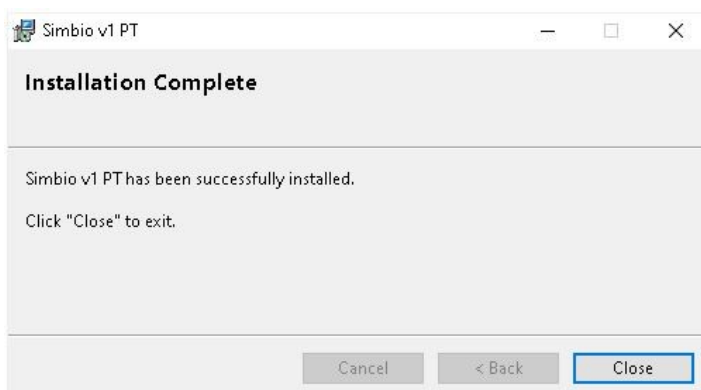

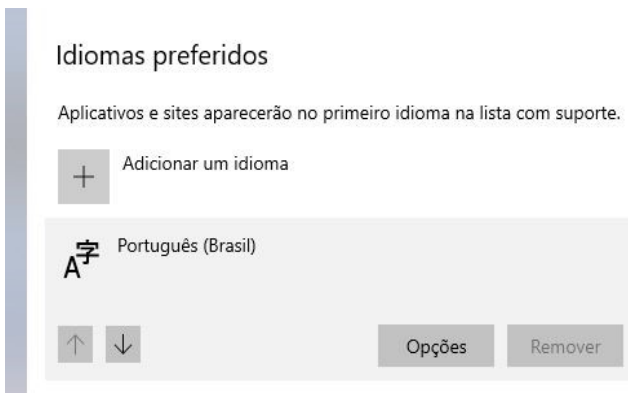
- After downloading, read the file (READ-ME i.e. LEIA-ME) and run the installer file (setup.exe).

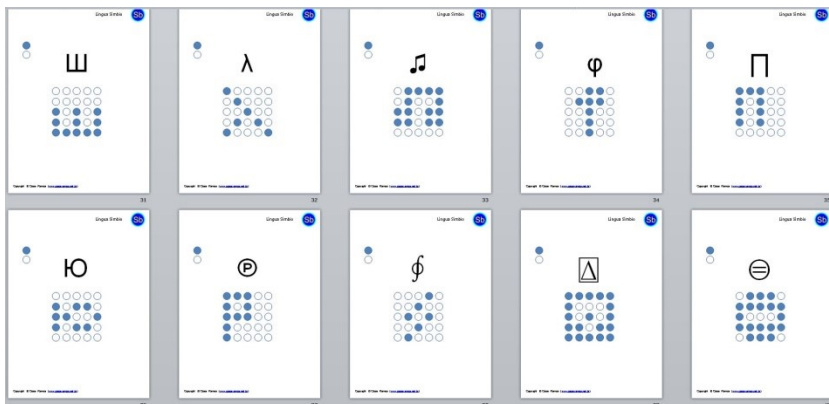
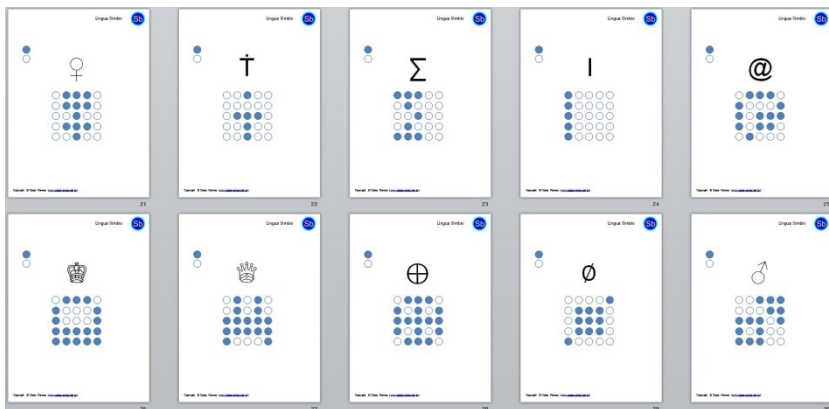
## Book XXII – Símbio for Visually Impaired

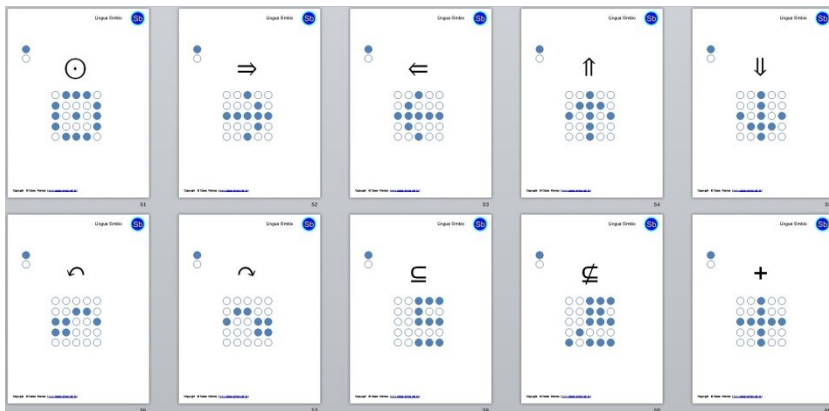
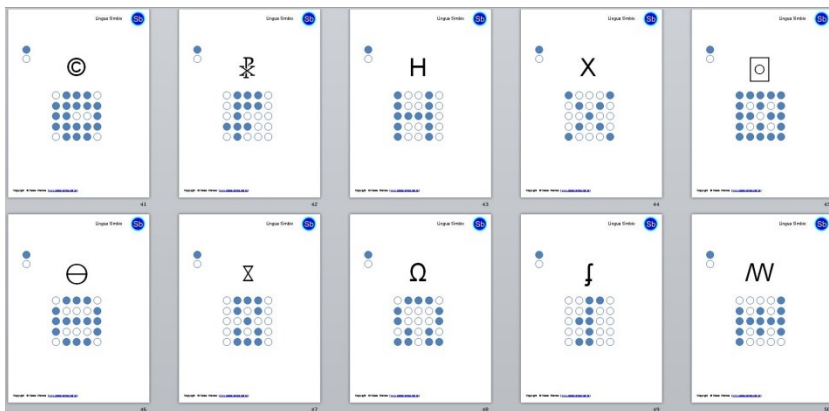
1. The derivation of the Símbio language I created for the visually impaired is presented in the following pages.
2. The transcription of the Símbio language adopts a cell with 25 protrusions (5x5) and abandons the Braille cell with only 9 protrusions (3x3).
3. In comparison to the Braille language, the Símbio language is much shorter. It requires fewer symbols.
4. The location and numbering of each protrusion in each cell can follow two patterns: the  $Sb\neq\odot$  pattern or the  $Sbb\neq\odot$  pattern that preserves positions 1 to 6 of the Braille writing code.
5. The best pattern should be determined by users and their representatives.
6. The boundaries of each cell should, in my opinion, be identifiable.
7. The personal and commercial use of the derivation of the Símbio language for the visually impaired follows the same rules as the use of the Símbio language.
8. Personal use is free, and commercial use is subject to a commitment to donate to the Ceti Order.



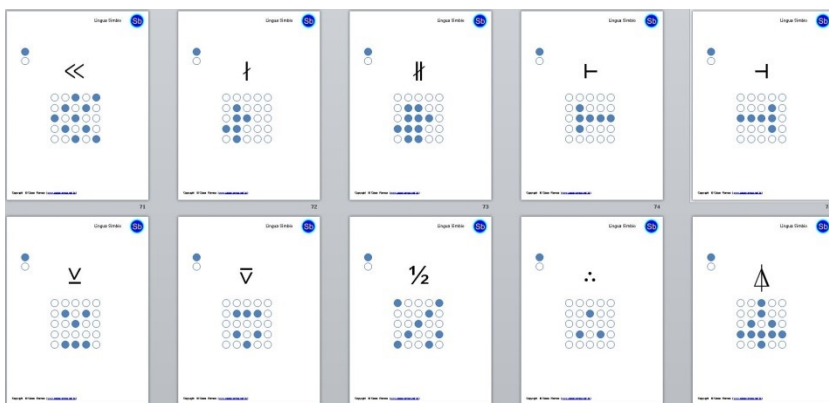
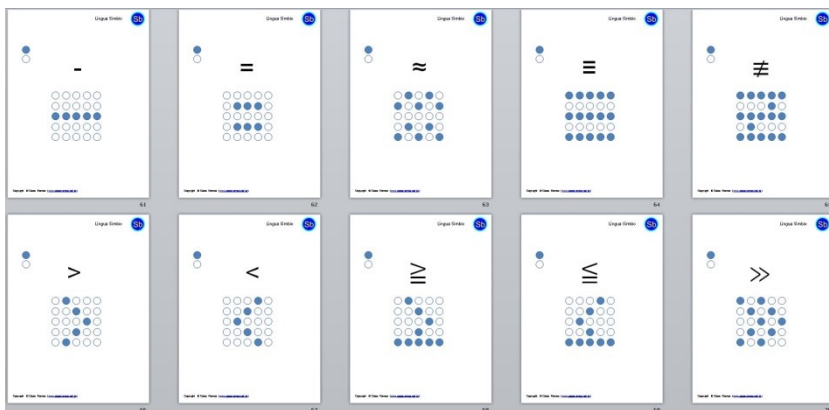


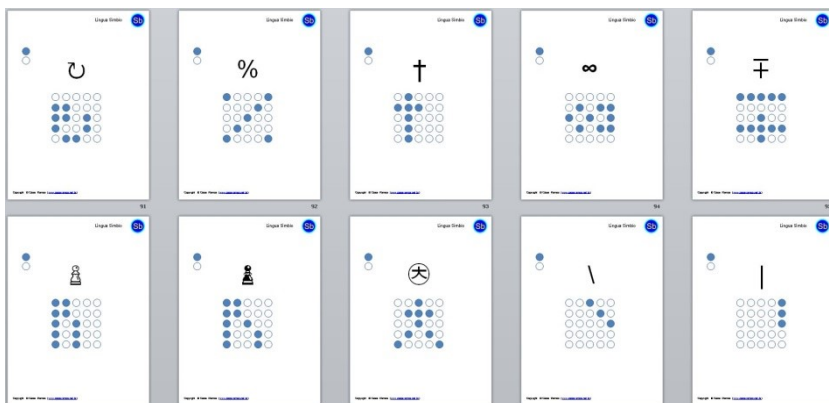
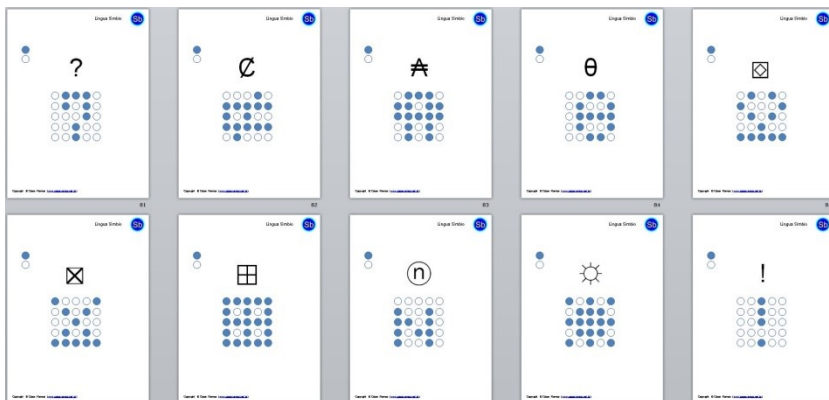
